<i>Spiritual Gifts</i> (see eg Romans 12:3-8)	Warmth, thoughtfulness
<i>Heart for...</i> (zeal for a need or cause)	People who need support
<i>Abilities/skills</i> (from education, work or life)	Ability to talk and to strike the right balance between coolness and over enthusiasm
<i>Personality</i> (extrovert/introvert, task or team, detail or big picture)	Friendly, helpful, a team worker
<i>Experiences</i> (good ones or painful ones if relevant here)	Experience of entering a church without a welcome, as opposed to the joy of a friendly greeting
